The Site Council is recruiting one new parent member for the 2008 -2010 school years and one alternate for the 2008-2009 school year. Site Council members must be voted in by the community and serve a two-year term with the alternate serving one. Elections will take place this school year, with the 2-year term being filled with the parent ranking 1 and the alternate filled with the second place candidate. All positions are important.

WHAT IS THE SITE COUNCIL AND WHAT DOES IT DO?

The Site Council is a state-mandated committee comprised of parent, staff and student members, who work together to develop and support the School Improvement Program (SIP). The SIP develops the site-specific programs that support the district strategic goals, including funding allocation and oversight. The goal of the Site Council is to ensure that teaching and learning at JLS are at the highest level possible, in an environment that allows the safety and success of all our students. Therefore to ensure that those individuals who are most affected by the operation of their school have a role in the decisions regarding how their school functions, please take this opportunity to get involved. Meetings are on Mondays, approximately once a month, from 3:30-5 p.m.
